The Materials Committee of the Metropolitan St. Louis Sewer District has granted tentative approval for the admixture product known as Con Shield. The product can be used in concrete structures for protection from microbial induced corrosion. The District will allow Con Shield in new and rehabilitated structures, to include: junction chambers, manholes, concrete pipe, and shotcrete work.

The liquid antibacterial admixture shall be an EPA registered material and the registration number shall be submitted for approval prior to use in a project.

The amount to be used shall be as recommended by the manufacturer of the antibacterial admixture. The manufacturer shall verify the effectiveness of the admixture for all installations by following the manufactures testing protocol. The test results shall be forwarded to the District within 45 days of taking the sample.
